STATE OF TENNESSEE'S NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK THE DEATH PENALTY

COMES NOW the State of Tennessee, by and through the District Attorney General's Office for the Twenty-Ninth Judicial District, and hereby gives Notice of its Intent to Seek the Death Penalty in the event the defendant is convicted of first degree murder pursuant to Rule 12.3 of the Tennessee Rules of Criminal Procedure. The State will rely on the following aggravating circumstances:

1. **STATUTORY AGGRAVATING CIRCUMSTANCES NUMBER TWO:** the defendant was previously convicted of one (1) or more felonies, other than the present charge, whose statutory elements involve the use of violence to the person, including Aggravated Robbery in Madison County, TN docket #14-CR-243;
2. **STATUTORY AGGRAVATING CIRCUMSTANCES NUMBER FIVE:** the offense was especially heinous, atrocious, or cruel, in that involved torture or serious physical abuse beyond that necessary to produce death;
3. **STATUTORY AGGRAVATING CIRCUMSTANCE NUMBER TWELVE:** the defendant committed "mass murder," which is defined as the murder of three (3) or more person, whether committed during a single criminal episode or at different time within a forty-eight-month period;


